Dr. Ronald Hall uses his diverse background as a veteran educational administrator to focus on the school's mission of helping each student achieve their individual potential. With over 25 years experience in teaching and working in administrative roles, Dr. Hall has acquired a variety of skills that benefit the enhancement of education and help him steer the school's continued commitment to students and area families.

After receiving his Bachelor of Arts in history from Alfred University in Alfred, NY, Dr. Hall taught social studies in grades 9-12 before pursuing his Masters of Arts in social science from Ball State University. While pursuing his master's degree, he worked as a doctoral assistant at the university before returning to secondary education as a middle school Principal and, later, an elementary school Principal at an Indiana public school.

Dr. Hall moved to Pennsylvania in 1998 and accepted an administrative position in charter school education, one year after passage of Act 22, which allowed the establishment of Pennsylvania charter schools. He helped open what is now School Lane Charter School in Bensalem (previously Mosaica Academy Charter School operated by Mosaica Education, Inc.), the state's first suburban charter school. After three years with Mosaica Education, Inc., he served 21st Century Cyber Charter as Chief Administrative Officer/Director. Immediately preceding his position with Graystone Academy, Dr. Hall spent six years as Director of the Eastern Support Center for PA Cyber Charter School, the school's first satellite office, as well as Director of Curriculum and Instruction.

Dr. Hall is a member of the Association of Supervision and Curriculum Development, the Coalition of Pennsylvania Charter Schools, two educational honor societies, and the National Association of Elementary School Principals. Throughout his career, he has given presentations to some of these organization's annual conferences. Additionally, his passion for education and public policy has led him to co-author the book, *The Craft of Public Administration, Teacher's Guide*.
